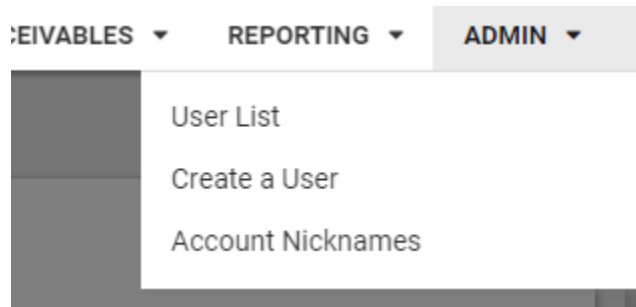


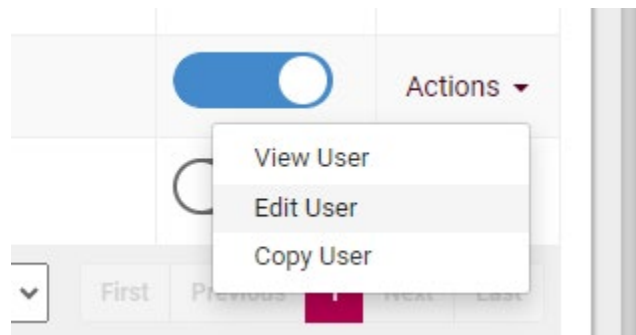
# IP Restriction Instructions

Please be aware enabling IP Restrict for a user will disallow any logins from IP addresses outside of those manually entered by an Admin user. Although we do not suggest disabling this feature once established, we are aware due to travel or for other reasons, a user may require accessing TM Online from an IP not initially listed. In those cases, it would be the Admin's discretion to disable IP Restrict to allow access from any IP addresses.

As an Admin user, going to Admin menu option then User List (unless creating a new user)



Select 'Actions' to the right of the user we wish to add IP Address for, followed by Edit User
